I joined Edmund Carr in July 2023 having recently completed my A level exams, in which I completed Maths, Business, Finance and Economics, at Helena Romanes Sixth Form. I am now studying for a level 4 CFAB qualification under an apprenticeship.

During this apprenticeship I have attended college where I am taught a subject such as Law, and then have an exam on this whenever I book it for. Edmund Carr does allow trainees to take 2 days off before the exam for revision which has really helped me feel more confident going into these exams. Alongside the college, the apprenticeship scheme requires you to do several tasks to prove how you have developed knowledge, skills and behaviours in the workplace. These skills are assisted by having to attend skills days like effective communication, leading yourself and teamwork.

I work in the audit and accounts department and prepare accounts for sole traders, partnerships, companies, and charities as well as auditing companies, academies and charities.
